A. Course description

This is an English conversation class of pre-intermediate level. This class is divided into two groups, 20 students in each, and is taught by two English teachers respectively. One is a native speaker of English, and the other is a Taiwanese English teacher. Group A are students of odd numbers, and group B are students of even numbers. In the first hour, group A take the foreign teacher's class, and group B go to the Taiwanese teacher's class. In the second hour, group A go on to take the class of the Taiwanese teacher and group B take the class of foreign teacher.

A. Target group description

The target group are students of the applied foreign language department. Most of them have learned English for at least 6-7 years. Students in 201 are in grade two, aged 16 to 17.

C. Course Objectives

1. Enhance students' listening ability.
2. Enhance students' speaking ability
3. Enhance students' language use and lexical competence of spoken English.
4. Enhance students' communicative skills.
5. Enable students to express themselves in English clearly and confidently.
6. Enable students to learn about the culture and customs of English speaking countries.
7. Develop students' global perspective.

E. Evaluation procedure

Two oral exams are administered by the foreign teacher. These two exams, which are mainly based on the textbook, account for 30 % of the grades in this semester. Another two listening and vocabulary exams account for 30 % of the grades, and will be conducted by the Taiwanese teacher. Students' participation and performance in class activities will take up another 40 % of the grades in this semester, which are marked by both the foreign teacher and Taiwanese teacher.
